## Show Car Registration

Q: What time do you open the gates?

A: Gates open at 9:00 am or when the frost is off the grass in the show area.

Q: Where do you park the show cars?

A: Cars are parked inside the ball park fencing initially with overflow parking behind the outfield fence.

- Q: How do I register my car?
  - A. Registration takes place the day of the event between 9am and 12pm. There is no pre-registration. Free dash plaque to the first 150 cars.
- Q: What is the fee to register?
  - A. \$5.00. All entries are eligible for a gas card drawing of \$100, \$50 or \$25 and hourly door prizes.
- Q: What types of awards are given out?

A: Ten awards will be presented. Specific categories are Best in class 1920's & older, 1930's and older, 1940's and older, 1950's and older, 1960's and older, 1970's and older, 1980's and older, 1990 and newer and finally "Most Unique Vehicle". All awards are framed certificates and are announced starting at 3:15.

Q: How are entries judged?

A: Awards are based on voting by participants as well as the spectators. Judges are not used to make the selection.

## **Craft Show**

Q: What time do the doors open to set up my crafts?

A: 7am

Q: Do I need to pre-register and who do I contact?

A: Not required but suggested. Floor space is assigned on a first in basis. Contact Donna Osgood at (920) 533-4807 to reserve your space or to ask questions.

Q: What space do I get and what is the registration fee.

A: The \$10.00 pre-registration fee covers an 8 by 8 area with one 6 foot table. Additional space is available for an additional charge. You can bring your own table. Space is available in or outside the building. Registration on day of event is \$15. Space inside is assigned on a first in basis.

## Food

Q: Do you serve food?

A: In the morning starting at 9am fresh homemade donuts and coffee is served until 3pm. At 11am we start selling sandwiches and sides until 3 pm. Menu includes brats, hamburgers, foot long hot dogs and pork sandwiches.

Q: Are beverages sold?

A: Coffee, water, soda and adult beverages are sold.

## Spectators

Q: IS there spectator parking and is it free?

A: Parking is free and there is plenty of parking behind the building. An area is reserved for those requiring special needs.

Q: Do you have raffles?

A: Raffles are available and include a bushel of booze and various other items including car related items.
